

Parent PLUS Loan Request Form

The Federal Direct Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students (PLUS) is an optional loan taken out by the parent of a dependent student. Approval of the Parent PLUS loan is based on a credit check and other eligibility requirements. How to Apply

- 1. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at https://fafsa.ed.gov/.
- 2. Complete and submit this Parent PLUS Loan Request form.
- 3. Complete the Parent PLUS Master Promissory Note (MPN) online at https://studentloans.gov/.

- Interest Rates and Fees: The Parent PLUS loan has a fixed interest rate and is subject to a fee deducted at the time of disbursement. Visit https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/types/loans/plus for complete details.
- **Disbursement and Refunds**: The Parent PLUS loan will be disbursed once per subscription period indicated in the requested loan dates. The loan funds will first be applied to the student's university account toward tuition and fees. Any additional loan funds will be mailed to the parent (borrower's) address as a refund.
- **Repayment**: The Parent PLUS loan enters repayment once the loan is fully disbursed. The loan servicer will contact the parent regarding repaying options.
- **Denial**: If the Parent PLUS loan request is denied due to adverse credit history, there are alternative options available. Call the UW Flexible Option Financial Aid Office at (877) 895-3276 to explore the options.
