

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter contains a summary of grading and term information for the <u>UW Flexible Option</u> degree program offered through the University of Wisconsin-Parkside.

<u>Academic Calendar</u> – The UW Flexible Option program includes 12 Subscription Periods (SP) per year, with each term beginning the 1st or 2nd Tuesday of the month. A SP runs 81 class days (approximately 12 weeks) and includes a 10 Day break between the end of one SP and start of the next. Faculty grades are due the Thursday following the end of each SP.

<u>Tuition</u> – Registered students pay a flat tuition rate of \$2,250 per SP, which covers as many courses as that a student can complete during one term.

<u>Grading</u> – Students are required to demonstrate mastery level work at 80% or higher for each competency set for which they enroll. The mastery grades of MD and M translate to a traditional letter grades of A (90% or higher) or B (80-89%), respectively.

^{*} An in-progress PR grade is given to students who have not mastered a course by the end of the SP. Students are required to achieve mastery within six attempts. A student is limited to five PR grades in any single course. A grade of "F" would then be reported on the sixth attempt.
