

TUITION

You'll pay a flat tuition rate of \$2,250 per 12week subscription period. A subscription period is the time in which you complete your courses. New subscription periods start every month. Tuition covers as many courses that you are able to complete within the subscription period.

You have control over the total cost of your degree. Ultimately, it's based on how much prior coursework and work experience you bring to the program, and how many subscription periods it takes you to complete the required curriculum. Everyone's pace is unique to them.
